Will is a member of the Department of Community Health and Epidemiology at Queen's University. He has been affiliated with Queen's since 1989 and currently holds the rank of Full Professor since 2008. Will also has a cross-appointment with the Department of Emergency Medicine (Queen's) and an adjunct appointment with the Departments of Medicine and Public Health Sciences at the Universities of Saskatchewan and Toronto, respectively.

Will is the Program Director for the Masters of Science in Epidemiology Program at Queen's, and teaches in the undergraduate medicine and life sciences programs, and the MSc and PhD graduate programs in epidemiology.

Will's research interests include:

- Injury and Trauma Surveillance and Prevention;
- Health and its determinants in Children and Youth;
- Farm and Rural Injuries;
- Emergency Medicine Research.
